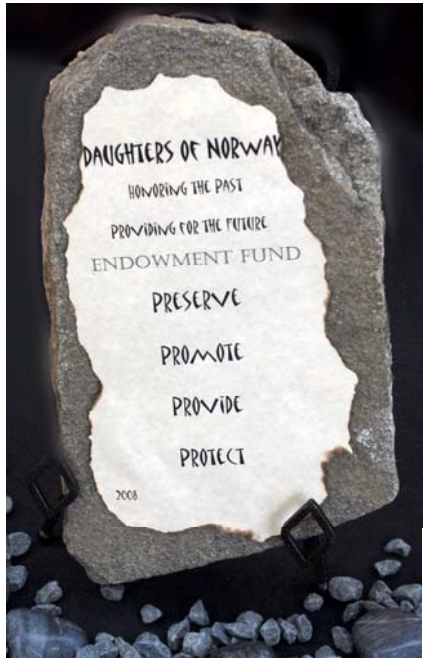

BACKGROUND

On July 19, 2008, the Grand Lodge Daughters of Norway Endowment Fund was established at the Centennial Convention. The endowment is an ongoing fund that will be held in perpetuity and provide renewable income in the form of interest on the invested principal. The principal of this endowment is not to be spent; only the investment earnings are available for spending purposes.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this endowment is to secure, provide and preserve income to be used for specified educational, charitable, and literary purposes to advance the goals of the organization. These purposes are clearly defined and restricted by the Daughters of Norway Constitution and the IRS.

FUNDING THE ENDOWMENT

The endowment is completely funded by voluntary contributions from lodges, members, other individuals, businesses, foundations, corporations, etc. A gift of any size will help us achieve our goal of securing and preserving our heritage. This may be a one time gift, a gift in someone's honor or memorial. Thank you for your consideration.
